LENGTH: Not less than 500 or more than 1000 words

Level 2 - Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

TOPIC: "The Irish Playing the Game: The Sports of the World"
LENGTH: Not less than 750 or more than 1500

ENTRY SUBMISSION:

- A paper version of the writing must be post-marked or delivered no later than 2/5/10.
- All submissions must contain a cover sheet with the author's name, address, phone number, grade, and school attending (if applicable).
- The author's name shall not be included in the body of the writing in order to ensure anonymity during judging.
